10:00-16:00 excursion in Tashkent:

Visit of **Hasti Imam Complex**, which consists of **Barak Khan Madrassah, Tillya Sheikh Mosque** - famous Koran Osman storage and golden hair of the Prophet Muhammad; **Juma Mosque, Kukeldash madrasah** and **Chorsu Bazaar**.

Next sightseeing of **Abdulkasym Madrasah** and **the State Museum of Applied Art of Uzbekistan**.

Independence Square: Independence Monument and **Happy mother arch "Ezgulik"** (Arch of kind and noble aspirations) with storks ascends upward, the **memorial of World War II; The memorial complex "Courage"**, eliminating the theme of consequences of the Tashkent earthquake in 1966; further the **Opera and Ballet Theater Square named Alisher Navoi, Amir Timur Square, famous Tashkent Chimes, Forums Palace** and other monuments of the modern city.

06:00 or **07:30** Meet with driver at the hotel. Transfer to Tashkent airport.

Departure to Bukhara, in accordance with flight schedule at **07:35** am or at **09:15** am.

Arrival Bukhara. Meet your guide and start the tour:

09:00-19:00 Excursion program in Bukhara:

Bukhara - one of the oldest cities in Central Asia and one of the greatest commercial centers on the Silk Road. Also Bukhara is museum city, where you can see more than 140 architectural monuments of the Middle Ages. The historical city center is included in the UNESCO World Heritage List. The sacred, whole-hearted and hospitable, Bukhara. You can never get tired while walking through its streets, surprising and delighted. A lot of historical movies have been shot on the squares of the city. Bukhara inspires the artists and photographers to create masterpieces, as well. It makes the mind clear and orders the thoughts. If try much, one can see the light Bukhara sheds... A lot of monuments, architectonic pieces and commercial buildings are preserved in the city, as well as bath-houses and palaces. The time has been merciful in relation to Bukhara by comparison with the other cities.

Citadel Ark - a city in the city (4th century BC), **Bolo House** (early 20th century) architectural **ensemble Poi-Kalon** (Pedestal of the Great), the religious heart of Holy Bukhara, consists of **Minaret Kalyan, Kalyan mosque** and **madrassa Miri-Arab. Ulugbek Madrasah** (1417), **Madrasah Nodir - Divan - Begi Madrasah Abdul Aziz Khan, Magoki-Attori** (12-16 cc.), **Lyabi Hauz** (14-17 century), the **Ensemble Kosh-Madrasah**, consisting of two opposing madrassas **Madari-Abdullakhan** mother Abdullakhan and madrassas Abdullakhan, **Samanids Mausoleum** (tomb of representatives of Samanids dynasty late 9th - early 10th centuries), **Chashma Ayub** (Job's Spring), **Chor Minor** (four minarets).

13:00 Lunch in one of the most beautiful restaurants in the old part of the city or in the national house.

19:00 Transfer to Bukhara airport, flight to Tashkent, scheduled air flights at **21:35**

23:00 Meet at Tashkent airport, transfer to hotel.

"SAMARKAND - THE BEATING HEART OF SOGDIANA"

Daily

07:00 Meet with driver at the hotel. Transfer to Tashkent railway station.
Transfer from Tashkent to Samarkand and back is carried out by high-speed train.

08:00 Departure of "Afrosiab" train to Samarkand.

10:10 Arrival Samarkand. Meet with guide and start of the excursion.

10:30 – 16:00 Excursion program in Samarkand:

The stones and walls of Samarkand, alike came to life chapters of the history, which you can infinitely skim. Its name is associated with the names of prominent scholars and poets of the Middle Ages - Rudaki, Alisher Navoi, Jami, Samarkandi, Ulugbek, Omar Khayyam, Avicenna, Rumi, Beruni and many others, who lived and created under the shadow of these hills.

Guri Emir Mausoleum – Tamerlane's Tomb (XIV-XV centuries) – The place where **Amir Temur** was buried, as well as his sons and grandchildren.

Registan Square – one of the outstanding examples of Central Asia urban art, formed in the VIIth century and consisting of three madrasahs – **Ulugbek** (1417-1420), **Sher-Dor** (1619-1636) And **Tillya-Kori** (1647-1660).

The chapters of Samarkand millenary history could be skimmed by its feat.

Bibi Khanum Mosque – the largest in Central Asia and one of the largest in the whole Muslim world. Exactly this building draws the eye of anyone, who enters the city. Enormous, majestic, silent...

13:00-14:00 Lunch in one of the most beautiful restaurants in the Old City or in national house.

Excursion continuance:

Architectural Complex Shakhi – Zinda (XI-XV centuries) – The place, where royalty and noblemen have been buried. Kussam ibn Abbas - The prophet Mohammed cousins' soi disant tomb is considered the main mausoleum that represents the borders of necropolis. He was so called «Shakhi – Zinda», that means "Live Czar" in translation from Persian.

Visit to the Mausoleum of Prophet Daniel – The prophet Daniel is revered by three world religions. He is one of the four great prophets of Judaism, the prophet, whose book was included in the Old Testament of the Christian Bible, and a prophet of Islam. Legend says that Amir Temur carried a part of Daniels remains, specifically, his hand to Samarkand.

The Observatory of Ulugbek (XV century) – Ulugbeks scientific works have been created by virtue of the unique observatory he built in Samarkand. The main tool used was a giant stationary quadrant placed inside the cylindrical building with a diameter of 48 m (the remnants of the foundation, or rather its trenches, were discovered during archaeological excavations).

16:00 Transfer to Samarkand railway station for Afrosiab train leaving to Tashkent.

17:00 Train leaves from Samarkand

19:10 Arrival to Tashkent, transfer to the hotel.
